





## Brain, Reasoning, Emotions

Brain Networks are Highly interconnected Connections are bi-directional: top-down, bottom-up




The Executive Control Network/ Central Executive Network typically matures in the mid 20s on average

## **Positive Psychology Lens**




"Human goodness & excellence are as authentic as disease, disorder and distress"


baseline vagal tone Positive Emotions
